We are a team of rural people whose aim is to help rural South Canterbury. Visit our website to see a list of our trustees and how to contact them.

The Trust has trained coordinators who travel to where they are needed. Contact is one-on-one at a place that suits you. Services are free and confidential.

The Trust covers the South Canterbury area between the Rangitata and Waitaki Rivers, from the ocean to the main divide.

OUR PURPOSE IS

To provide support in personal and/or financial difficulties:

Often all you need is someone to talk to. Our coordinators are trained to help and can refer you to suitable professionals e.g. financial/farm management, mentoring and counselling.

To facilitate: We can work on your behalf with financial organisations, government agencies and farm advisors.

To help during and after an adverse weather or environmental event: We work with Civil Defence to provide information to help you get emergency or ongoing aid, such as: rescue of stock; access to Rural Assistance Payments and labour; or whatever you need to get back on your feet.
